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International Coffee Council 113th Session 22 – 26 September 2014 London, United Kingdom International Coffee Agreement 2007 Membership as at 8 September 2014

Background

- 1. The attached document contains a report on membership of the International Coffee Agreement (ICA) 2007. In April 2014 the Executive Director circulated document DN-118/14/ICA 2007 notifying Members of the opportunity to deposit instruments during the 113th Session of the Council in London.
- 2. The Executive Director urges all Governments that have yet to complete membership formalities for the 2007 Agreement to make every effort to accelerate the procedures required.

Action

The Council is requested to consider this report.

INTERNATIONAL COFFEE AGREEMENT 2007 MEMBERSHIP AS AT 8 SEPTEMBER 2014

Background

1. The ICA 2007 was adopted by the International Coffee Council on 28 September 2007 through Resolution 431. On 25 January 2008, the Council designated the International Coffee Organization (ICO) as the Depositary for the Agreement and it opened for signature at the ICO headquarters in London on 1 February 2008 until 31 August 2008, and for deposit of instruments of ratification, acceptance or approval until 30 September 2008. The period for signature was subsequently extended until 28 September 2011 (see Resolutions 439, 441 and 445) and the period for deposit of instruments was also extended by the Council until 30 September 2014 (see Resolutions 440, 442, 446, 448, 449 and 452).

Status of the 2007 Agreement

- 2. The ICA 2007 entered into force definitively on 2 February 2011 in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of Article 42 of the ICA 2007.
- 3. As at 8 September, 44 exporting Members and 6 importing Members have signed the Agreement, and 39 exporting Members and 6 importing Members have ratified, accepted or approved the Agreement or deposited notifications of provisional application (see Annex I). The attached table shows the status of membership under the ICA 2007. Governments are listed in the following four categories:

Section A: Members of the 2007 Agreement

Section B: Members of the ICA 2001 which have signed the ICA 2007 but not completed

the required procedures

Section C: Members of the ICA 2001 which have not signed the ICA 2007

Section D: Countries invited as observers to attend the 98th Session of the Council at

which the ICA 2007 was adopted.

Deposit of instruments of ratification, acceptance or approval

4. Under the provisions of Resolution 452, signatory Governments have until 30 September 2014 to deposit instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession. Document WP-Council 246/14 contains a draft Resolution extending the deadline for deposit of instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession until 30 September 2015. Procedures for membership are set out in document ED-2033/08 Rev. 8, together with a model instrument. Following the expiry of the deadline for signature on 28 September 2011, accession is the only option for membership open to non-signatory Governments (see paragraph 6 below).

Notification of provisional application

5. Under the provisions of Article 41 (Provisional application), a signatory Government which intends to ratify, accept or approve the 2007 Agreement may, at any time, notify the Depositary that it will apply the Agreement provisionally in accordance with its legal procedures. The Plurinational State of Bolivia, Colombia and Papua New Guinea are currently applying the Agreement provisionally.

Accession

6. Accession is generally used by States wishing to express their consent to be bound by a treaty where the deadline for signature has passed. Article 43 (Accession) provides that the Government of any State member of the United Nations or of any of its specialized agencies or any intergovernmental organization described in paragraph (3) of Article 4 may accede to the 2007 Agreement in accordance with procedures which shall be established by the Council. At its 106th Session, the Council approved Resolution 447 establishing procedures for accession, in accordance with Article 43 of the 2007 Agreement. The deadline for deposit of instruments of accession is currently **30 September 2014**. Document WP-Council 246/14 contains a draft Resolution extending the deadline for deposit of instruments of accession until 30 September 2015. Information about procedures for accession is contained in document ED-2033/08 Rev. 8, together with a model instrument.

Members of the ICA 2001 which have not yet completed procedures for the ICA 2007

7. Countries which have not yet completed membership procedures will only be required to pay contributions to the Administrative Budget in 2014/15 from the date they become Members¹. The Executive Director has written to the designated persons for countries listed in Sections B and C of Annex I to remind them of the need to complete membership procedures as soon as possible.

Participation at meetings and credentials

8. As has been the procedure since the entry into force of the 2007 Agreement, countries which were Members under the 2001 Agreement but have not yet completed procedures for the ICA 2007 may continue to attend meetings and receive ICO documents, pending the formal completion of membership procedures. These Members are long-standing Members of

previous Agreements, and this practice was followed under the ICA 1994 as extended and the ICA 2001. Although these Members may be invited to take their seats in the Council, they would not be eligible to participate in the formal decision-making process.

9. In the case of the report on credentials, these Members will continue to be grouped as countries which have not yet completed the formal procedures for membership of the ICA 2007, but were Members under the ICA 2001 and have sent representatives to this Session. A similar procedure was followed in the case of Council Sessions held under the ICA 2001².
