**Exports of all forms of coffee  
to exporting countries  
Calendar years 2000 to 2013 and  
January-June 2014**

### **Background**

1. With the entry into force of the ICA 2007 in February 2011, exporting Members are now required to provide monthly information on the volume and value of their imports of coffee by form and type, and by origin. The information presented in this report is based on data collected from a variety of sources. Some exporting Members experience delays in collecting this information as they may have to contact their Customs Authorities and/or Central Banks to obtain the data.

2. Table 1 shows the volume of exports by origin to exporting countries in calendar years 2000 to 2013 and in the first six months of 2014. Graph 1 shows the volume of total exports of all forms of coffee to exporting countries as the declared final destination by both exporting and importing countries. In the case of some exporting and importing countries, data for 2013 and 2014 have been estimated.

3. In the first half of the period covered in this report, 71% of the exports originated in exporting countries. This share increased to just over 90% in 2012 and is estimated to be slightly over 87% in 2013. The total volume exported to exporting countries in 2013 is estimated to reach 10.8 million bags, 13% lower than that exported in 2012.

4. The top 10 exporting countries, declared as the final destination for exports and with volumes higher than 150,000 bags GBE in 2013 are: the Philippines, Mexico, India, Ecuador, Indonesia, Colombia, Venezuela, Thailand, Vietnam and Cuba – see table 2. Graph 2 shows the percentage share of these countries in the total for 2013.

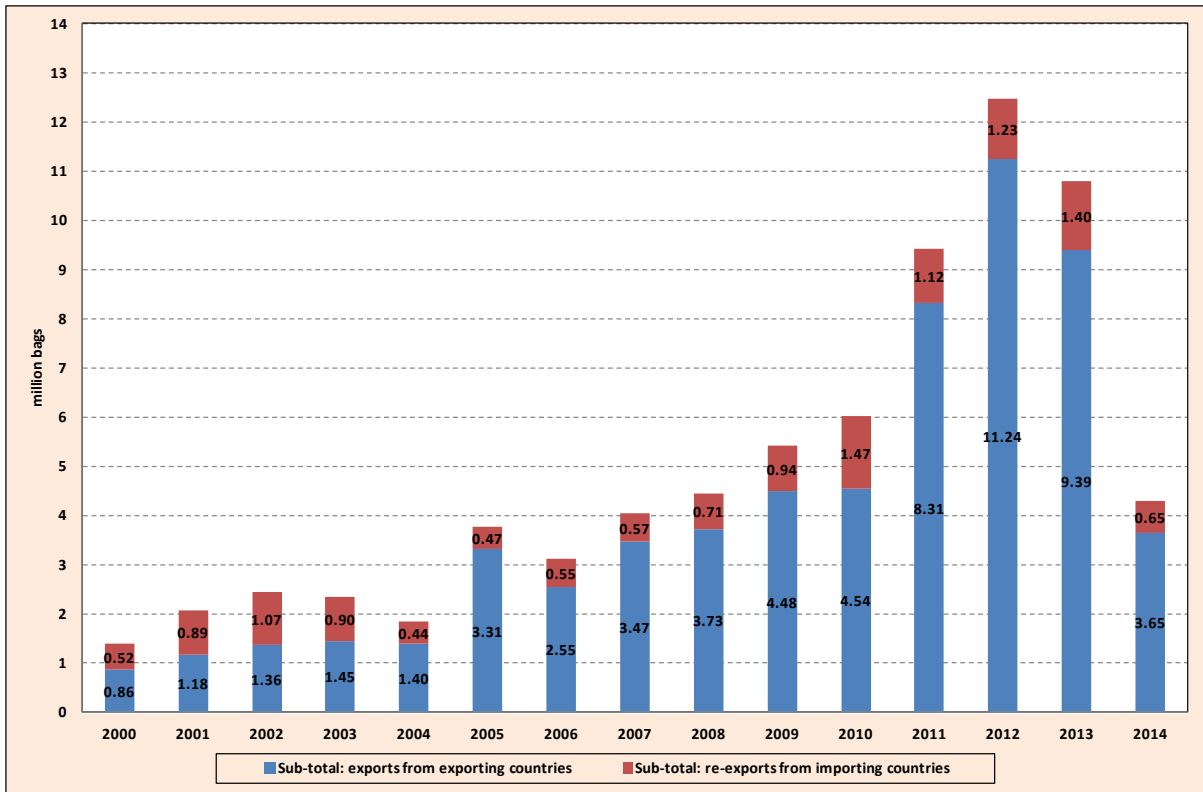
5. Data on this segment of the market will become more reliable once exporting Members fully implement the new Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, contained in document [ICC-102-10](#), by providing reports on their imports of coffee.

6. The Organization will continue to monitor exports to exporting countries.

**CALENDAR YEAR 2013**

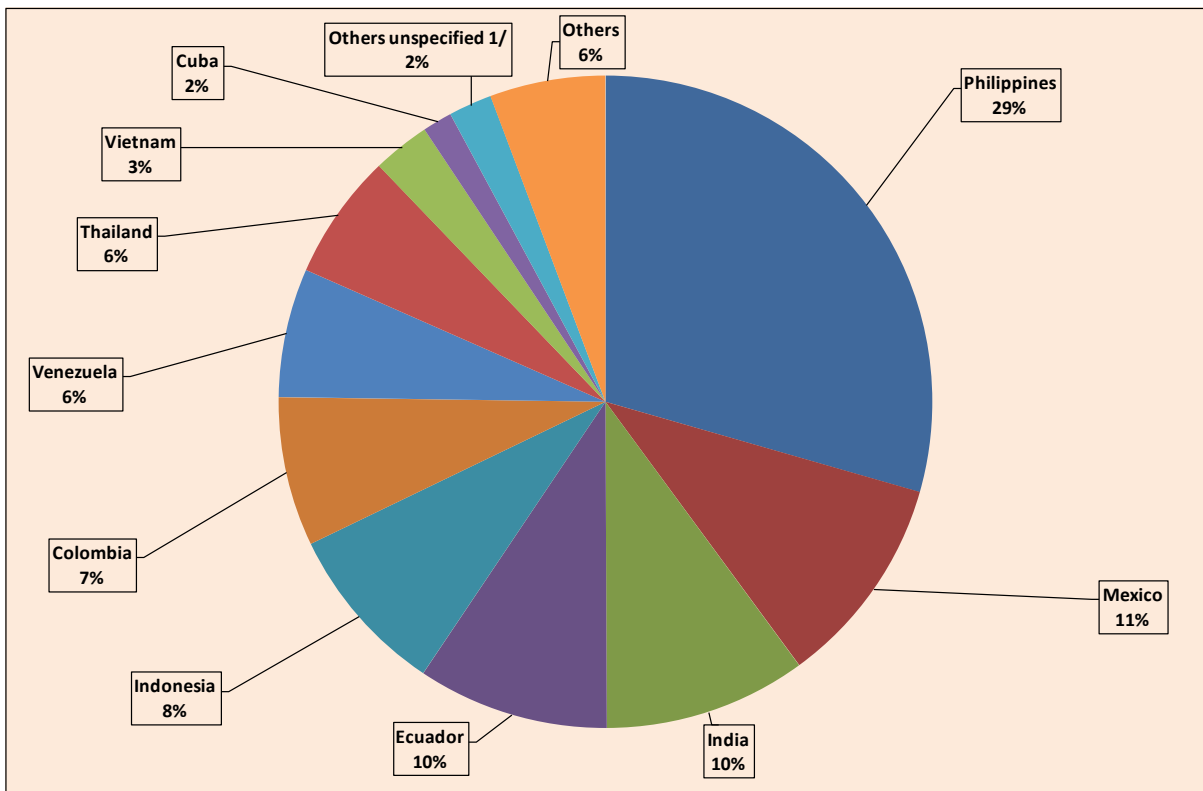
