	 Report on the meeting of 4 March 2015 – to approve Compliance with statistical rules – to consider The Senior Statistical Assistant will report on compliance with the Rules on Statistics and actions following the last meeting with respect to countries which are not complying with the Rules. The Head of Operations a.i. will report on the work of the Statistics Roundtable to discuss the provision of statistical data. Article 2 of the 2007 Agreement provides that the Council shall, as soon as possible after the entry into force of the Agreement, and at intervals of three years, review the conversion factors for roasted, decaffeinated, liquid and soluble coffee. The last review of conversion factors took place in September 2011 (see ED-2123/11). The Committee will consider this matter.

At the request of Members during the March 2015 meeting the Secretariat has contacted soluble coffee manufacturers. The Head of Operations a.i. will report.
