The ICO calls on the global coffee community to support earthquake victims in Ecuador

The Executive Director of the International Coffee Organization (ICO) wishes to convey his sincere condolences to the Government of Ecuador and its people following the devastation left behind by the earthquake that hit the country on 16 April 2016. Hundreds of people have died and thousands were injured in the six affected provinces.
