Request for credentials for the 119<sup>th</sup> Session of the Council (London, United Kingdom 13 to 17 March 2017)

## **Credentials for ICO meetings**

- 1. The International Coffee Organization presents its compliments and wishes to remind Members that Rule 3 of the Rules of the Organization requires them to inform the Secretariat, in writing, of the names of their representative, alternates and advisers. In view of the need to finalise the arrangements for the 119<sup>th</sup> Session of the International Coffee Council and other meetings taking place in London, United Kingdom, from 13 to 17 March Members are requested to send their credentials with details of designated participants to the Secretariat by **27 February 2017** via the dedicated email address <u>credentials@ico.org</u>.
- 2. Credentials should be issued in writing by the competent authorities designated by the Member (i.e. either the relevant Ministry or government agency of the Member country or by a representative of the Diplomatic Mission of the Member concerned either in the country where the seat of the Organization is located or where a session takes place). Members are requested to coordinate with their authorities to avoid issuing duplicate credentials. Faxed credentials may be accepted; however, Members are requested to provide original credentials after the session for record purposes.
- 3. Members are also reminded that if they are unable to attend, in accordance with paragraph (2) of Article 13 of the 2007 Agreement, any exporting Member may authorise in writing any other exporting Member, and any importing Member may authorise in writing any other importing Member, to represent its interests and to exercise its right to vote at any meeting or meetings of the Council.
- 4. The Secretariat will examine the credentials of delegations and report to the Council on 17 March 2017. An example of a credential is attached as Annex I for the information of Members. An example of a letter authorising a Member to represent another Member which is not attending the meetings is attached as Annex II.
