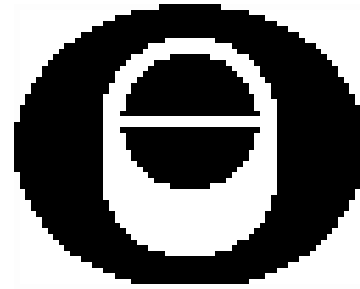

AFCA & ICO Signed MoU in September 2017 at THE 120TH ICO MEETING IN COTE D'VOIRE

The draft Coffee Profiles prepared:

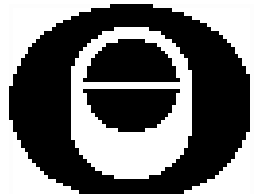

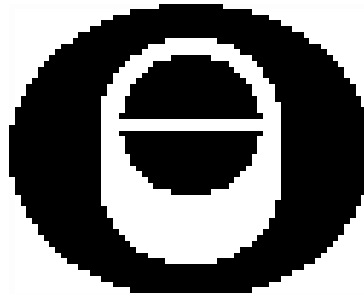
