## INTERNATIONAL COFFEE AGREEMENT 2007 CONCLUDED IN LONDON, 28 SEPTEMBER 2007

## STATUS OF MEMBERSHIP

The Executive Director of the International Coffee Organization (ICO), as the chief administrative officer of the Depositary for the International Coffee Agreement (ICA) 2007, communicates the following:

The deadline for signature of the International Coffee Agreement (ICA) 2007 expired on 31 August 2008. Thirty-two Governments (28 exporting and 4 importing Governments) signed the Agreement by the deadline, including four new Members (Liberia, Timor-Leste, Turkey and Yemen). Two exporting Members (Kenya and Vietnam, holding 13.90% of the votes of exporting Members) and two importing Members (the European Community and the United States of America, holding 89.80% of the votes of importing Members), have ratified, accepted, or approved the Agreement as at 1 September 2008. The deadline for deposit of instruments of ratification, acceptance or approval by signatory Governments is: **30 September 2008**.

The International Coffee Council will review the position of membership at its 101st Session from 22 to 26 September 2008 and establish procedures for accession to the 2007 Agreement by non-signatory Governments.

Information about procedures for depositing instruments of ratification, acceptance or approval is contained in document ED-2033/08 which includes a model instrument.

1/ Paragraph (1) of Article 42 of the ICA 2007 provides that the Agreement shall enter into force definitively when signatory Governments holding at least two-thirds of the votes of the exporting Members and signatory Governments holding at least two-thirds of the votes of the importing Members, calculated as at 28 September 2007, without reference to possible suspension under the terms of Article 21, have deposited instruments of ratification, acceptance or approval (see EB-3934/07).
