**Basis for the distribution of votes  
among exporting Members  
for coffee year 2010/11**

1. The Executive Director presents his compliments and wishes to remind Members that, under the provisions of paragraph (5) of Article 13 of the International Coffee Agreement 2001, the distribution of votes is determined by the Council at the beginning of each coffee year.
2. In order to permit the Council to take a decision on the distribution of votes among exporting Members for coffee year 2010/11 it is necessary, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (3) of Article 13, to establish the average volume of their exports of coffee to all destinations in the preceding four calendar years, that is from 2006 to 2009.
3. The table attached has been prepared as far as possible on the basis of information received from exporting Members up to 22 September 2010 and it will be used as the basis for the initial distribution of the votes of exporting Members in coffee year 2010/11.
4. Information on the basis for the distribution of votes among importing Members for coffee year 2010/11 is contained in document ED-2092/10 Rev. 1.
