It is the legal successor to the erstwhile International Jute Organization (IJO).

- List of producing, consuming, exporting and importing countries of FGIB.
- Country wise domestic consumption (volume & value) of FGJB.
- Export and import (volume & value) of FG[B.
- The issues of tariff and non-tariff barrier in FGIB sector.

The IJSG Secretariat will appreciate if you kindly provide the latest information/data/statistics at the soonest. We also warmly welcome any suggestion from you which can be worked out in the collaboration between us.
