**Progress report on the implementation
of the Coffee Quality-Improvement
Programme (CQP)
Calendar years 2005 to 2010**

Background

1. Resolution 420 requests exporting Members to indicate in box 17 of all Certificates of Origin, on a voluntary basis, information on the quality of the coffee exported by defects and moisture content. This allows the monitoring of the level of compliance with the target standards set out in the Resolution on the basis of the data received.
2. The information presented in this document is based on data received from Certificates of Origin (in electronic or paper format) issued to cover coffee exported in the six full calendar years – 2005 to 2010 – since Resolution 420 came into effect. It also contains information on progress in the implementation of the CQP in exporting Member countries in this period. The previous report on the implementation of the CQP is contained in document EB-3977/10.
3. The entry into force of the ICA 2007 has automatically brought into effect the new Rules on Statistics – Certificates of Origin – contained in document **ICC-102-9**. Although it is still voluntary for exporting Members to provide the information requested in Box 17 of the new Certificate of Origin, it is expected that they will be encouraged to comply with this request as the various data fields in this area are now visible on the Certificate to ensure greater market transparency.

Action

The Promotion and Market Development Committee is requested to take note of this report.

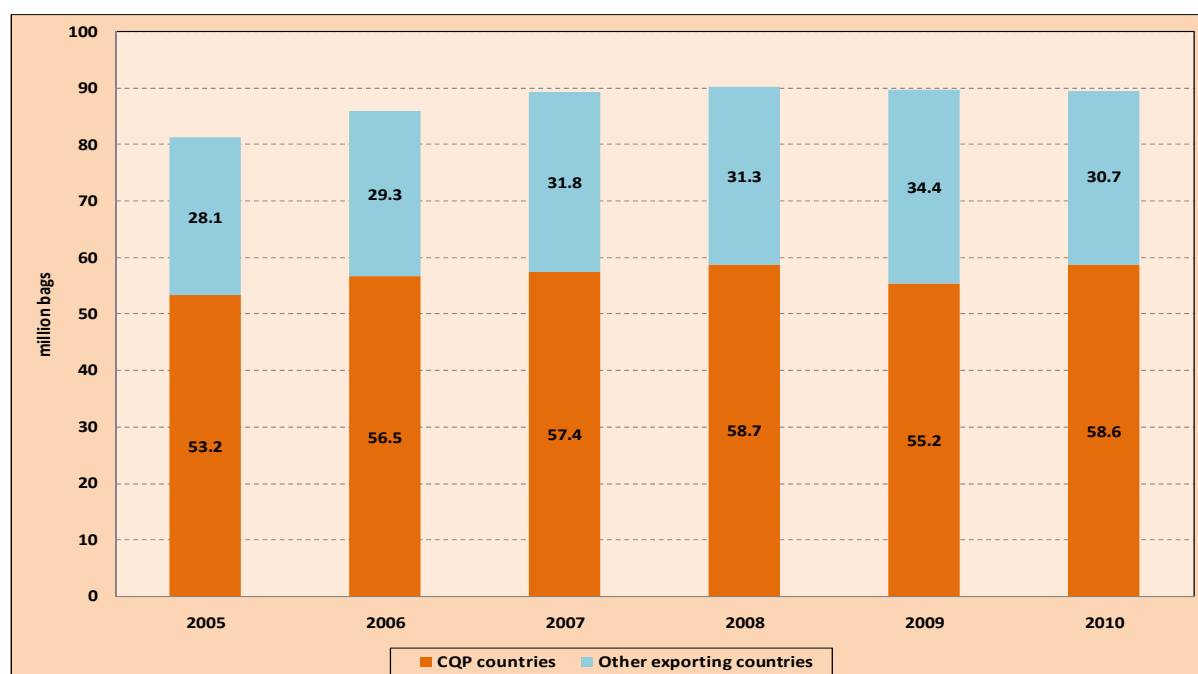
**PROGRESS REPORT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
COFFEE QUALITY-IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME (CQP)
CALENDAR YEARS 2005 TO 2010**

1. Since Resolution 420 came into effect in June 2004, 28 exporting Members have provided information on the quality of the coffee they export, through Certificates of Origin. From 2005 to 2010, these 28 exporting Members accounted, on average, for about 65% of world exports of green coffee in the period.

2. The total volume of green coffee exported by all exporting countries in the six complete calendar years (2005 to 2010) averaged 87.5 million bags. The total volume of green coffee exported by the 28 countries participating in the CQP averaged 56.6 million bags in the same period. However, four Members have effectively failed to provide information on their exports for the whole period.

3. Table 1 shows the volume of green coffee exported by each exporting Member effectively participating in the CQP in calendar years 2005 to 2010. This table also gives the volume of green coffee exported each year classified in accordance with the parameters set out in Resolution 420. The graph below shows the total volume of green coffee exported by the countries participating in the CQP in the period covered by this report.

4. Table 2 shows the data given in Table 1 with the breakdown into Arabica and Robusta.

5. The Organization will continue to monitor compliance with Resolution 420 by exporting Members.
