**Compliance with the provision of  
statistical data: during ICA 2001 and  
the first 12 months of ICA 2007**

## Background

1. This document provides information on the compliance of Members with the provision of statistical data during the lifetime of the ICA 2001 and the first 12 months of the ICA 2007.
2. The information contained herein covers coffee years 2001/02 to 2010/11 and the first four months of coffee year 2011/12 – October 2011 to January 2012. It should be noted that the additional requirements contained in the new Rules on Statistics have not been taken into account for the period starting 2 February 2011 – the entry into force of the ICA 2007. Therefore, the situation on the provision of information for each year, which are presented in the respective Annexes, are still based on the old Rules.
3. It should be noted that the current Rules on Statistics, contained in documents ICC-102-9 – Certificates of Origin; and ICC-102-10 – Statistical Reports, came into effect on 2 February 2011. Members were given until 31 January 2012 to fully implement these Rules in their countries – see document ED-2128/12.
4. Compliance by exporting Members in respect of the provision of timely statistics based on monthly statistical reports and/or Certificates of Origin in coffee years 2007/08 to 2010/11 is given in Annex 10. Similarly, Annex 11 shows the compliance by importing Members in the same period.

## Action

The Statistics Committee is requested to examine the compliance status of each Member of the Organization, in order to make the appropriate recommendations to the Council.

**COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF STATISTICAL DATA**  
**COFFEE YEARS 2001/02 TO 2010/11**  
**OCTOBER 2011 TO JANUARY 2012**

**Statistics provided by exporting Members**

- *Preliminary monthly exports (Annex 1)*

1. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **30 days** after the close of each month, information on the total exports in the previous month. If final figures are not available, provisional figures or estimates may be provided (see paragraph 3 (a) of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document ICC-102-10<sup>1</sup>).

- *Monthly Reports on exports (Annex 2)*

2. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report. This information should be based on the relevant Certificates of Origin issued to cover coffee shipped during that period under report and should comply with the format specified in Annex I-B of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document ICC-102-10.

- *Certificates of Origin (Annex 3)*

3. Exporting Members are requested to transmit data in electronic files or to forward the first copy of each Certificate of Origin together with a copy of the relevant Bill of Lading to the Organization (see paragraph 5 of Rule 4 of the Rules on Statistics – Certificates of Origin, document ICC-102-9<sup>2</sup>). For the first four months of coffee year 2011/12, 18 exporting Members, which together accounted for 87.2% of world exports, have sent data electronically<sup>3</sup>. Of the 25,396<sup>4</sup> records stored in the database for the first four months of coffee year 2011/12, 25,351 records – equivalent to 99.8% of the total – were received electronically, whereas 45 records – equivalent to 0.2% – were actually keyed in.

4. The entry into force of the ICA 2007 has introduced some changes to the procedures set out in the previous Rules. Any exporting Member that may encounter difficulties with the implementation of the current Rules should contact the Organization to request assistance. The volume of exports from exporting countries from which no information has been received by the Organization represents 2% of the total volume exported in the first four months of 2011/12. As established in paragraph 4 of Article 33 of the ICA 2007, exporting Members that have opted to issue an alternative document are required to send electronic data or the equivalent document used to replace the ICO Certificate of Origin.

- *Monthly prices paid to growers (Annex 4)*

5. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the average price received by growers for their produce or the minimum price, if any, guaranteed by the Government to the growers on a monthly basis (see paragraph 1 (a) of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document ICC-102-10).

- *Annual data on opening stocks, production and internal consumption (Annex 5)*

6. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization estimates of production and domestic consumption for the current crop year and the following crop year and closing stocks at the end of each crop year (see paragraph 1 (b) and (c) of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document ICC-102-10). Those exporting Members producing/exporting more than one type of coffee or using different processing methods (dry and wet) are also requested to indicate, in percentage terms, the type and method of processing. Information on the crop percentage distribution by quarter and the area under coffee and number of trees should also be sent on an annual basis (see paragraph 1 (c) of document ICC-102-10).

- *Report on imports (to come into effect from February 2012)*

7. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization **monthly** information on the volume and value of imports of coffee, if any, by form (and type, where applicable) by country of origin. This information can be provided according to the relevant Harmonised System (HS) codes by product. Where monthly information is not available, annual data should be provided within **60 days** after the end of each calendar year (see paragraph 1 (a) of the Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, document ICC-102-10).

- *Monthly retail prices (to come into effect from February 2012)*

8. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the representative retail market prices for roasted and/or soluble coffee for the month under report (see paragraph 1 (a) of document ICC-102-10).

#### **Statistics provided by importing Members**

- *Monthly Reports on imports and re-exports (Annex 6)*

9. Importing Members are requested to send complete reports to the Organization by email or fax, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of imports by form of coffee and by country of origin and on the volume and value of re-exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report (see paragraph 3 (c) of document ICC-102-10).

- *Monthly retail prices (Annex 7)*

10. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the representative retail market prices for roasted and/or soluble coffee for the month under report (see paragraph 2 (a) of document ICC-102-10).

- *Information on roastings (Annex 8)*

11. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the amount of green coffee that has been roasted at the end of each quarter/calendar year, if available (see paragraph 2 (b) of document ICC-102-10).

- *Information on inventories (Annex 9)*

12. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the stocks of green coffee held by importers and roasters on the last day of the quarter/calendar year, if this information is available (see paragraph 2 (b) of document ICC-102-10).

- *Information on changes made on taxes and duties, laws and regulations of coffee exports and imports in the country*

13. **All Members** are requested to send to the Organization information on changes or revisions in the current level of taxes and duties on coffee exports/imports, or to the laws and regulations of coffee exports/imports in the country (see paragraphs 1 (d) and 2(c) of document ICC-102-10).

#### **Compliance with Resolution Number 420**

14. Following the adoption of Resolution Number 420 by the Council in May 2004, exporting Members have been requested to comply with the provisions of the Resolution. However, as this compliance is voluntary, the information on quality received from exporting Members has been monitored for coffee shipments that have taken place since the Resolution came into effect. Document PM-13/12 contains the latest progress report on the implementation of the Coffee Quality-Improvement Programme.

#### **Summary tables and conclusions (Annexes 10 and 11)**

15. Annex 10 shows that compliance with the Organization's statistical requirements is full and satisfactory for 20 out of 33 exporting Members of the ICA 2007. This represents 68.9% of average exports in coffee years 2007/08 to 2010/11. Exports by 23 producing non-member countries represent 5.8% of total exports in this period. Similarly, Annex 11 shows full and satisfactory compliance by 31 importing Members<sup>5</sup> representing 99.7% of average annual imports by all importing Members in the same period. It should be noted that Tunisia is the only importing Member still to comply with the statistical Rules of the Organization. Efforts will continue to be made so that the authorities in this country will eventually comply with the Organization's statistical rules.

16. There are 7 exporting Members of the ICA 2007 failing to comply with their statistical obligations. Total exports by these Members represent only 0.5% of the average exports in the period under consideration. In addition to these, another 6 exporting Members, together accounting for 24.8% of the exports in the period, also show a poor compliance performance.

17. Except for Brazil and Costa Rica, the timely provision of production and internal consumption estimates by all other producing countries continues to be unsatisfactory, particularly in the last three years (see Annex 5). Exporting Members are reminded that this information is essential for the reliability of the statistics and for the accuracy of the supply/demand analysis released by the Organization.

18. Exporting and importing Members are required to keep the Organization informed of any changes to their existing level of taxes and duties on imports and exports of coffee and on the laws and regulations currently in effect in each country.

19. The following economic study has been prepared and will be presented to Members at the 108<sup>th</sup> Session of the Council:

ICC-108-1                      Coffee drinking patterns in selected importing countries

20. The entry into force of the ICA 2007 has automatically brought into effect the Rules on Statistics contained in documents ICC-102-9 and ICC-102-10, Certificates of Origin and Statistical Reports, respectively. Members were given 12 months to adapt their systems to the new requirements set out in these Rules. This period expired on 31 January 2012 and it is expected that full cooperation will be received from all Members in complying with these new Rules from February 2012.
