**Exports of all forms of coffee  
to exporting countries  
Calendar years 2005 to 2010  
and January to June 2011**

## Background

1. With the entry into force of the ICA 2007 last February, exporting Members are now under the obligation to provide monthly information on the volume and value of imports of coffee by form and type, and by origin (on a regular basis). As Members have 12 months to adapt their systems to the new requirements, the information presented in this report is still based on the reports and data collected from various sources.
2. It should be noted that some exporting countries may experience delays in meeting this request due to the need to obtain the information from the Customs Authorities and/or Central Banks.
3. Table 1 shows the volume of exports to exporting countries in the period by origin. Graph 1 shows the volume of total exports of all forms of coffee to exporting countries as the declared final destination by exporting and importing countries, in calendar years 2005 to 2010 and in the first six months of 2011. In the case of importing countries, data for 2010 and 2011 are partial as the information from a few importing non-members is still being compiled. Graph 2 shows the share of exporting countries as the destination of the exports in 2010.
4. On average, 83% of exports to exporting countries are originated in exporting countries with the remainder 17% originating in importing countries. The accumulated volume in the first six months of 2011, which is still partial, appears to indicate that the volume of exports to exporting countries at the end of 2011 might even be higher than that recorded in 2010.
5. The top five exporting countries declared as the final destination of these exports are: Colombia, Ecuador, Indonesia, Venezuela and Thailand. Data on exports to this segment of the market will become more reliable after all exporting Members fully implement the new Rules on Statistics – Statistical Reports, contained in document ICC-102-10.
6. The Organization will continue to monitor the exports to exporting countries.

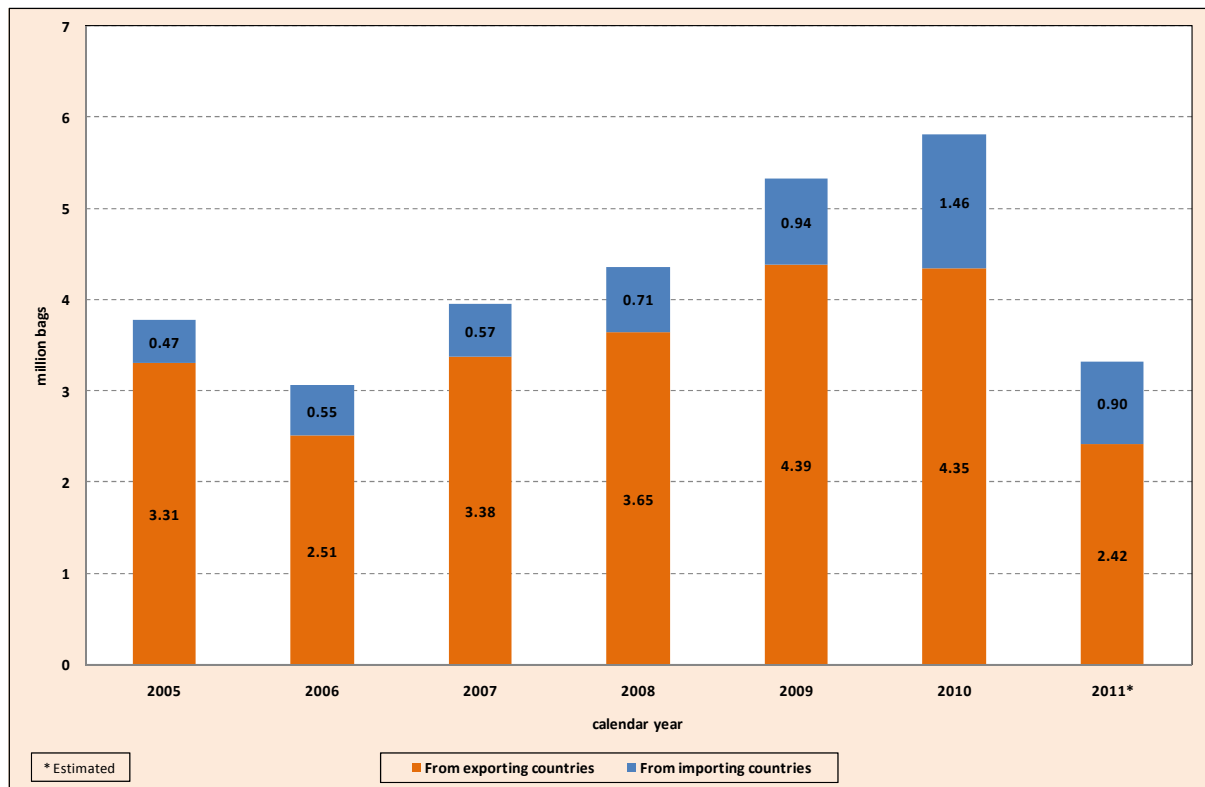
