**Exports of organic coffee
(and certified programmes)
Calendar years 2005 to 2010 and
January to June 2011**

Background

1. With the entry into force of the ICA 2007 last February, it should be possible to collect more accurate data on the exports of organic¹ coffee and certified programmes based on Certificates of Origin. As Members have 12 months to adapt their systems to the new requirements, data presented in this report are still based on Certificates of Origin and Statistical Reports issued by those Members that have been providing this information voluntarily.
2. Tables 1 and 2 show the volume of exports of organic coffee by exporting Members, in calendar years 2005 to 2010 and in the first six months of 2011 by origin and by destination based on Certificates of Origin and Statistical Reports, respectively. Graph 1 shows the evolution of exports of this segment of the market in the period covered by this report based on both sources.
3. Since 2005 there has been an increase in providing information on organic coffee exports via Statistical Reports – from 7.5% of the total reported in Certificates of Origin in 2005 to over 86% in 2010. As more detailed reports are received, the reconciliation between the two sources becomes a less demanding task which will ideally be unnecessary.
4. The Organization will continue to monitor the exports of this segment in the market.

Action

The Statistics Committee is requested to take note of this document.

¹ In accordance with the Rules on Statistics – Certificates of Origin contained in document ICC-102-9, exporting Members undertake full responsibility for ensuring that the certification of organic coffee complies with the specifications set out in ISO Guide 65 – General Requirements for bodies operating products certification.
