Compliance with the provision of statistical data during the seven complete years of the ICA 2001: Coffee years 2001/02 to 2007/08

#### **Background**

- 1. This document provides information on the compliance of Members with the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports (document EB-3830/02) approved by the Council in September 2002. In the case of exporting Members, it also gives their compliance with the Rules for the application of a system of Certificates of Origin contained in document EB-3775/01.
- 2. The information contained herein covers the life of the 2001 Agreement seven complete coffee years: 2001/02 to 2007/08. It gives the requirements for the supply of statistical information with details of specific problems for each year in the respective Annexes.
- 3. Compliance by exporting Members in respect of the provision of timely statistics based on monthly reports and/or Certificates of Origin in coffee years 2004/05 to 2007/08 is given in Annex 10. Similarly, Annex 11 shows the compliance by importing Members in the same period.
- 4. It should be noted that in September 2008 the Council approved amendments to the current Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports contained in document EB-3830/02. The new Rules will be circulated to all Members as soon as the new Agreement comes into effect.

#### **Action**

The Statistics Committee is requested <u>to examine</u> the compliance status of each Member of the Organization, in order <u>to make</u> the appropriate recommendations to the Council.

## COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISION OF STATISTICAL DATA COFFEE YEARS 2001/02 TO 2007/08

#### **Statistics provided by exporting Members**

- *Preliminary monthly exports (Annex 1)*
- 1. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **30 days** after the close of each month, information on the total exports in the previous month. If final figures are not available, provisional figures or estimates may be provided (see paragraph 3 (a) of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).
  - *Monthly Reports on exports (Annex 2)*
- 2. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report. The information should be based on the relevant Certificates of Origin issued to cover coffee shipped during that period under report and should comply with the format specified in Annex I-B of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02.
  - Certificates of Origin (Annex 3)
- 3. Exporting Members are requested to transmit data in electronic files or to forward the first copy of each Certificate of Origin together with a copy of the relevant Bill of Lading to the Organization (see paragraph 5 of Rule 4 of the Rules on Statistics – System of Certificates of Origin, document EB-3775/01). For coffee year 2007/08, 20 exporting Members, which together accounted for just over 83% of world exports, have sent data electronically<sup>1</sup>. Of the 101,682 records contained in the Certificates of Origin database for coffee year 2007/08, 99,002 records – equivalent to over 97% of the total – were received electronically whereas 2,680 records – equivalent to below 3% – were actually keyed in. Plans on how to provide assistance for the implementation of an efficient statistical system in exporting Members showing poor compliance with the statistical rules are still being considered. The entry into force of the ICA 2007 will bring into effect some changes to the current Rules<sup>2</sup> so it would be wise to wait until the 2007 Agreement enters into effect to review this matter. In the meantime, any exporting Member that may be encountering difficulties with the implementation of the current Rules is welcome to contact the Organization to request assistance. The reduction of 6% in the number of records received in the current coffee year, compared with the previous one, is mainly due to partial data received from some Members.

- *Monthly prices paid to growers (Annex 4)*
- 4. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the average price actually received by growers for their produce or the minimum price, if any, guaranteed by the Government to the growers on a monthly basis (see paragraph 9 of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).
  - Annual data on opening stocks, production and internal consumption (Annex 5)
- 5. Exporting Members are requested to send to the Organization quarterly estimates of production and domestic consumption for the current crop year and the following crop year and closing stocks at the end of each crop year (see Annex I-A and paragraph 2 of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02). Those exporting Members producing/exporting more than one type of coffee or using different processing methods (dry and wet) are also requested to indicate, in percentage terms, the type and method of processing.

#### Statistics provided by importing Members

- Monthly Reports on imports and re-exports (Annex 6)
- 6. Importing Members are requested to send complete reports to the Organization by email or fax, not later than **60 days** after the close of each month, information on the volume and value of imports by form of coffee and by country of origin and on the volume and value of re-exports by form of coffee and by country of destination for the month under report (see Annexes II-A and II-B and pages 3 and 4 of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).
  - *Monthly retail prices (Annex 7)*
- 7. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the representative retail market prices for roasted and/or soluble coffee for the month under report (see paragraph 10 of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).
  - *Information on roastings (Annex 8)*
- 8. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the amount of green coffee that has been roasted at the end of each quarter/calendar year, where available (see paragraph 3 (a) of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).

- *Information on inventories (Annex 9)*
- 9. Importing Members are requested to send to the Organization information on the stocks of green coffee held by importers and roasters, including stocks in free ports where such exist, on the last day of the quarter/calendar year, if this information is available (see paragraph 3 (b) of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02).
  - Information on changes made on taxes and duties, laws and regulations of coffee exports and imports in the country
- 10. All Members are requested to send to the Organization information on changes or revisions in the current level of taxes and duties on coffee exports/imports, or to the laws and regulations of coffee exports/imports in the country (see paragraph 5 of the Rules on Statistics Statistical Reports, document EB-3830/02). Compliance with this specific item is covered in paragraph 16 below.

#### **Compliance with Resolution Number 420**

11. Following the adoption of Resolution Number 420 by the Council in May 2004, the Executive Director issued document ED-1918/04 requesting exporting Members to comply with the provisions of the Resolution. As compliance with the provisions of the Resolution is voluntary, the information on quality received from exporting Members could be monitored for coffee shipments that took place from 1 June 2004. Document EB-3958/09 contains the latest progress report on the implementation of the Coffee Quality-Improvement Programme.

#### **Summary tables and conclusions (Annexes 10 and 11)**

- 12. Annex 10 shows that for 23 exporting Members compliance with the Organizations' statistical requirements is full or satisfactory. This represents 84% of average exports in coffee years 2004/05 to 2007/08. Exports by ten producing non-member countries represent less than 4% of total exports in this period. Similarly, Annex 11 shows full or satisfactory compliance by 29 importing Members representing over 98% of average annual imports by all importing countries in the same period. It should be noted that two EU Members, namely Bulgaria and Hungary, are still to comply with the statistical Rules of the Organization.
- 13. There are 13 exporting Members failing to comply with their statistical obligations. They represent just over 1% of the average exports in the period under consideration. In addition to these, 9 exporting Members, together accounting for 11% of the exports in the period, also show a poor compliance performance. Plans to provide technical assistance to exporting countries are still under consideration and will be reviewed upon the entry into force of the ICA 2007.

- 14. Four exporting Members, namely Brazil, Guatemala, Honduras and India, have agreed to prepare a manual of best practice which would be used to assist those countries with poor or no compliance with the provision of statistical information. These countries have yet to report on the preparation progress of this manual. Contacts will be made with the authorities concerned during the meetings to seek clarification on this matter.
- 15. Compliance by most exporting Members to provide production and internal consumption estimates was unsatisfactory, particularly in the last two years (see Annex 5). Members are reminded that the provision of this information is extremely important for the reliability of the statistics and for the accuracy of the supply/demand analysis released by the Organization.
- 16. Bulgaria and Hungary are still reluctant to comply with the Statistical Rules of the Organization. Efforts will continue to be made so that the authorities in these countries will eventually comply with the Organization's statistical rules.
- 17. Exporting and importing Members are required to keep the Organization informed of any changes to their existing level of taxes and duties on imports and exports of coffee and on the current laws and regulations currently in effect in each country. In respect to some importing Members, various sources have been used to compile and integrate this information into our records.
- 18. The entry into force of ICA 2007 will bring into effect all the recommendations and amendments to the Rules on Statistics made by the Committee. It is expected that full cooperation is received from all Members in adopting the approved Rules as soon as possible.
