Funding and funding strategy

- Start with \$1.5M/year in 2012
 - 5-6 major industry donors
 - 20-30 medium-small roasters
 - 10 machinery manufacturers
- Build to \$5M/year by 2015
 - Expand to Europe, Japan, Australia, and Korea
 - Partner with major foundations, bilateral and multilateral donors
 - Increase major industry donors to 12
 - Increase medium and small roasters >100

Funding mechanism

Checkoff program

- Roasters contribute \$0.005/lb. to GCQRI on green coffee purchases
- manual system: 5yr agreement between roaster and GCQRI
- Importer assesses levy and includes as green coffee invoice
- Importer transfers funds to GCQRI every month
- GCQRI prepares roaster report and other ancillary docs

Non-checkoff contribution

- Direct discussion and negotiation of amount and billing period
- Large companies
- Machinery manufacturers
